....we'd love to meet you.

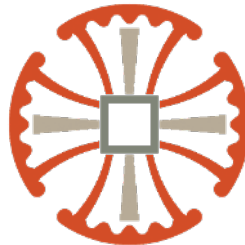


Chalke Valley Fete 2026
