## COOMBE BISSETT COFFEE & BOOKS

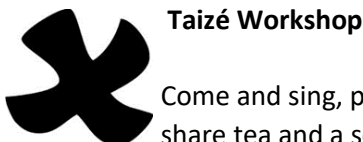
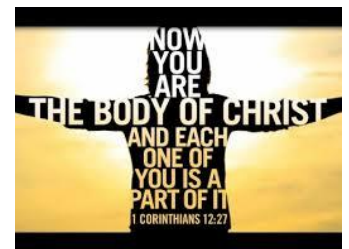

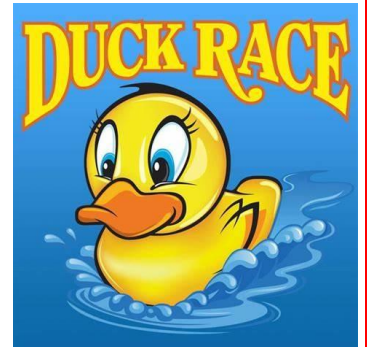
## **Update from Uganda**
